**RE: Return to Work Rule, Definition of Prohibited Post-Retirement Service (PPRS)**

***This Summary of Material Modifications (SMM) is an update to the Plan's Summary Plan Description (SPD) and describes how the amendments may affect your rights under the Plan. This SMM is considered a part of the SPD and you should retain a copy for your records.***

Effective for Reemployment After Retirement and Early Retirements commencing on or after July 1, 2021, the definition of Prohibited Post-Retirement Service as defined in the SMM dated October 28, 2021 is amended as follows:

**Prohibited Post-Retirement Service (PPRS)** includes employment in the State of Alaska and:

- a. In the building and construction trades, road construction, environmental remediation, and pipeline trades in which the job classification is similar to those set forth in a Laborers Collective Bargaining Agreement, and
- b. Including employment under a Collectively Bargained Agreement not negotiated by Laborers 341 or 942 if the employment meets the criteria in a. above.
- c. And further including employment as an owner, supervisor, superintendent, estimator or expeditor in a business which meets the criteria in a. and b. above if the employer is not under contract with either Local 341 or 942.
